RE: HANDLING OF OCCUPANCY REQUIREMENTS FOR
DEPLOYED ARMED SERVICES PERSONNEL

At the March 2005 meeting of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners, Georgia introduced and the Executive Committee passed a Resolution supporting our Armed Forces personnel.

This Resolution acknowledges that Armed Forces personnel are deployed on short notice with little time to address personal business affairs. With many homeowner and personal property policies containing exclusions for vacant or unoccupied property, the potential exists for Armed Forces personnel to be penalized in the underwriting or claims process for situations beyond their control.

You are hereby directed to review underwriting and claims procedures and to waive occupancy requirements for deployed Armed Forces personnel.
